WE ARE OPEN

While the theater may be “closed” for gatherings, the Church is open. We are a diverse family of neighbors, workers, parents, artists, and students who would love to meet you. We aren’t streaming or replicating Sunday mornings because we aren’t the Church gathered right now, we are the Church scattered.

LOVING THROUGH SAFETY
